

Terms of Use

Last Updated: April 23, 2025

These terms of use (“**Terms**”) govern your access to and use of the Northwest Asian Weekly (“**NW Asian Weekly**”, “**we**”, “**us**”, or “**our**”) Site currently at <https://nwasianweekly.com/> and all other content, features, services, and communications we provide in connection with the Site (the “**Site**”). **By accessing the Site, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree with these Terms, you must not access or use the Site.**

We may modify these Terms in our sole discretion by posting a new version of the Terms to this page. We will also update the "Last Updated" date at the top of these Terms when we make changes.

Your continued use of the Site will confirm your acceptance of the revised Terms. If you do not agree to the revised Terms, you must stop using the Site. We encourage you to review the Terms from time to time to ensure you understand the terms and conditions that apply to your access to, and use of, the Site.

By using the Site, you represent that you are at least 13 years old. If you are under the age of 18 (or the age of majority in your jurisdiction), you should use this Site only with the involvement and consent of a parent or legal guardian.
